KEEPING YOUR BATHROOM CLEAN & SAFE

AFTER EVERY USE

Ventilate

After you have used the shower/bath, always leave the door or window open for a while to keep your bathroom well-ventilated.

WEEKLY

Wipe Basin

Clean the basin gently with a dry or slightly damp cloth, ensuring no water drips down the sides. Remember to also wipe neatly around the drain!

Wipe Toilet

Carefully wipe the toilet, including under the seat, with warm soapy water. If using bleach in the toilet, leave the lid up to prevent discolouration.

Open out for more!



WEEKLY CONTINUED

Wipe Walls

Gently clean the walls using a damp cloth and warm soapy water.

Wipe Screens & fixtures

Clean screens, including glass shower screens with glass cleaner, then dry using a dry cloth for a streak-free shine. Clean taps & drain covers with a damp cloth.

Clean Shower Drain

Maintain your shower drain by removing the cover and the small water-filled pot. Clear all debris, rinse it with warm soapy water, and then securely replace it.



WEEKLY CONTINUED

Clean Floor

Ensure the floor is dry before cleaning. Vacuum or sweep to remove dirt, then mop with warm soapy water and allow it to dry once more.

Wipe Silicone

Clean silicone areas with a dry cloth to maintain hygiene and prevent bacterial buildup.

MONTHLY

Clean Shower Head

Detach the shower head by swiveling it off, then rinse thoroughly with warm soapy water.

CAUTION! Never use bleach apart from inside the toilet bowl
